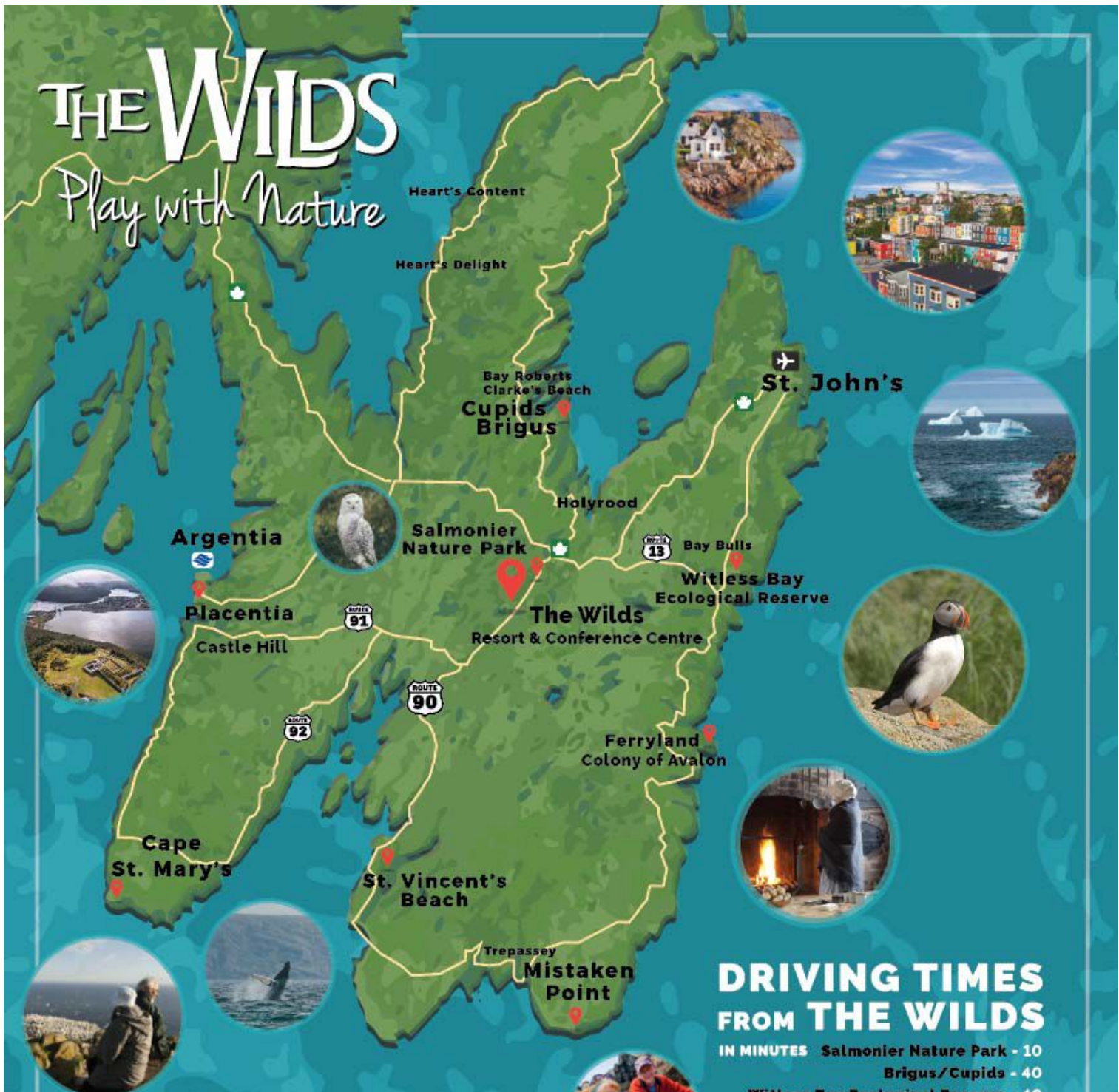

FAST FACTS

- **Castle Hill National Historic Site.** A link to Newfoundland's British and French colonial heritage when these two superpowers fought for control of North America.
- **Cape St. Mary's Ecological Reserve.** The most accessible Northern Gannet colony in North America.
- **St. Vincent's Beach.** The deep-water shoreline and food source, capelin, allow for dramatic up close and personal whale watching from land.

- **Brigus/Cupids Area.** Archaeological and National Historic Sites, hikes and festivals in picture perfect towns.
- **Mistaken Point, UNESCO World Heritage Site.** The oldest, fossilized examples of complex multicellular life-forms found anywhere on Earth
- **Colony of Avalon National Historic Site.** Widely recognized as the best preserved early English colonial site in North America
